

 \mathbf{C}

I teach people how to become more confident (自信的) through lessons and talks. I always start by telling people, "I was not a confident person before." They don't believe that. In fact, I had a hard time because I always thought something bad would happen. I'm going to tell you how I became more confident, as well as how you can be.

Firstly, I always compared myself to other people as I grew up. I worried about my appearance (外表) because I thought the other children had nicer clothes than me. I tried to dress like them, but I never felt comfortable. After a while, I found that copying them made me unhappy. So stop copying other people, whether it's wearing the same clothes, having the same hobbies, or doing the same jobs. You need to tell yourself, "I don't want to be like anyone else; I just want to be me."

The difficulty with trying to "be me" is that sometimes you don't know who you are. If you care too much about what other people think, you might not know important to you. That's why I think you should make a list of the things the important. I don't mean lists of what you have, like a nice car or popular shoes, but behaviour (行为), such as, "I think it's important to be kind and helpful." This will help you know yourself better and understand what behaviour you're most comfortable with.

Another reason you might not feel confident is that you're afraid of not achieving your goals (实现目标). I **postponed** doing difficult things because I was worried about doing them wrong. I hoped to be more ready before facing them. One day, I knew that if I didn't face my worries, I'd never become more confident. It won't be easy, but you need to set goals and hold on to them. Tell yourself, "I'm not going to give up, and it's going to make me more confident in the future."

The wonderful thing about becoming more confident is that you'll feel better about yourself in many ways. You'll have healthier relationships, you'll know yourself better, and you'll learn to do things that you thought were impossible. You'll still get worried from time to time, but it won't stop you from achieving your goals.



Make a Difference Day

Do you know about Make a Difference Day? It is a day of helping others. It began in the US in the 1990s. It is on the fourth Saturday in October, and this year it falls on 26th October. The idea behind it is to ask people to do something good for their neighbourhood. People don't need to spend a lot of time or money on it. It's just doing something to help make someone's life a little better.

There are lots of ways you can make a difference to people you know or even strangers. Cooking a meal or cleaning your room can make a difference at home. You can also make a difference at school by being kind to someone in the playground or helping your classmates with their lessons. What's more, you can make a difference for your neighbourhood by giving your unwanted books, clothes or toys to those who need them or by taking part in a litter pick.

"Last year in primary school, I helped out in a Grade One class every week. I helped the pupils with their work. I also read with them. It gave them some one-on-one help, and they grew in confidence talking with older children. I enjoyed working with them and helping with their learning journey at school." Rapha, an 11-year-old boy, shares his story.

Maria Evans, a middle school teacher, says it's important to do something nice for another person because it can make the kindness pass from one person to another. "The things you did show them they are important. You may get closer to others. Your kindness might let them help others too."

When you do something nice for someone else, you're showing yourself that you can make a positive (积极的) change for others. You feel able to make a real difference. It is important when life sometimes seems difficult.

You might think making a difference is just about helping others, but Evans says it's great for your happiness too. "You can meet new people and build up friendships. It's a good way to let you believe in yourself because it lets you know that you are important and able to change."
