C

The batteries we normally use have two noticeable problems, both of which lie in the materials. Firstly, lithium (锂), commonly used in batteries, is believed to be expensive and cause water and land pollution. Besides, most batteries use a liquid electrolyte(液体电解质). These liquids are flammable, which means they can catch fire easily.

Scientists from the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL) are working hard to make new materials for batteries, and they've got help from artificial intelligence(AI).

The PNNL scientists focused on solid (固体) electrolytes, trying to use less lithium in the meanwhile. They began with more than 32 million possible materials. The AI program studied this list.“The first step was to find out the ones that are stable (稳定的),”said Kandler Smith, an expert from the PNNL,“Many of the materials in the list would not work in a real lab, because these materials are not stable.”Then AI started its job by studying the 32 million materials, and cut the list down to half a million at a speed that surprised everyone. The team then chose



other ways to limit the number of materials. Cost to make the material was one example. In the end, scientists were left with 18 finalists. They studied these materials, and finally narrowed down to one new material. And they built a working battery from it!

Smith was very impressed that it took AI just over 80 computer hours to finish the task. The same work would have taken about 20 years if done through experiments in a lab. With solid electrolytes, the newly-built batteries are hopefully more stable and much less flammable. Moreover, the new material has 70% less lithium than a normal battery. Batteries made with this material could cost less in the future.

But one problem is that the newly-built batteries charge (充电) much more slowly, which scientists would need to work on. Still, Smith believes it's an excellent starting point. He is excited about the impact of using AI. It has really sped up the work scientists could do. The same program could help scientists in hundreds of other fields.

#### D

Mary has always been one of the best students in her class. She often says to herself: "If I try a bit harder, I can improve still more." Once again, her grades top the list when she enters high school. But then she begins to worry: "How can I keep this up? What if I get a bad grade? What would others think? How can I look myself in the mirror if I'm not perfect?"

Mary is an example of a high-achieving student whose outstanding performance in school has made her a perfectionist. Perfectionists often have very high standards and are overly critical (批评的) of themselves if they fall short of those standards.

A study among students aged 12 to 19 shows that high academic (学业的) achievement is a common reason for the development of perfectionism. It has long been believed that perfectionism leads to better performance. In this view, perfectionism has a bright side because it drives students to perform better and better. But the new study questions this. Actually, it supports the opposite idea—high performance leads to increases in perfectionism. That is, it's not perfectionism that makes students better at what they do, but the other way around. Continuous positive feedback (反馈) seems to push students to work harder for more and, as they realize they can reach their high goals, they raise their standards even higher.

It should also be noted that research generally points to the benefits of high academic success. However, this



new study once again challenges that idea. Academic success may come with certain costs. Students may come to see it as both a responsibility and a burden(负担), believing that they need to keep this perfect image that has already been formed. So, students who have achieved academic success are likely to suffer from the fear of making mistakes, performing poorly in exams and losing the respect of others. If they do so, they've fallen into the trap(陷阱) of perfectionism.

There are many top students like Mary, who are used to getting the best grades. They have developed a perfectionistic mindset, thinking their lives would be destroyed if they ever failed. It's very important that these students should learn not only how to achieve academic success, but also how to deal with that success without falling into the trap of perfectionism.

Animal cafés can be mainly divided into two modes(模式). The first mode raises animals in the café and is usually welcomed by customers who don't have pets. These places ch arge admission (收费). The second mode simply allows pet s to visit and enjoy coffee time with their owners. There is no admission charge. But the customers need to order drinks and snacks if they stay in an animal café with their own pets.“I prefer to choose a café that allows me to bring along my own cat.”Yu Miao, a 30-year-old cat owner said.

Pets are the highlight of animal cafés, but they can also present trouble. Some doctors remnd the probable hygiene-related(卫生相关的) food problems caused by animals. Many café owners also say that there are sometimes incidents of animals biting or scratching(抓伤) customers. It is important not to run after animals or try to pick them up by force.
