


#### Healthy eating for teenagers

Teenagers' diets should do good to their growth and health. If you have teenager kids, you must find out a number of changes take place inside their bodies. They influence nutritional needs. You also notice that they begin to develop real independence (独立) from you. They would like to make decisions about the food they eat. They choose a kind of food because their friends think it's good. They will also choose some good food which is helpful when they do sports.

A survey (湖首) shows us information on the nutritional intake and physical activities young people in the UK often take part in. The findings show average (平均) intake of sugar and salt is too high, while that of fibre is low. Besides, they've found that more than half of the young people don't often eat any citrus fruits (such as oranges and grapes), green leafy vegetables (such as cabbages or broccolis), eggs or tomatoes. It also shows that there are more and more overweight (制值的) tecnagers. It suggests

that many young people are cating too much.

However, teenagers need more energy. We all hope that foods in the diet should be rich in energy and nutrients. Providing calories (卡路里) in the form of sugary or fatty snacks means low nutrient intake, so they should be encouraged to choose all different kinds of foods (See



it in the picture). Besides, you should give your kids some other suggestions. For example, drink six to eight glasses of water a day. Eat regular meals, including breakfast,



as it can provide important nutrients and make you feel more energetic (精力充沛的] in the mornings.



Many studies show that teenagers, especially girls, are dissatisfied (不過度的) with their weight, but in fact they are not fat at all. They would choose the most popula ways of losing weight. They don't have breakfast, or they don't eat red meat and snack: and even not eat at all, so they can't stay healthy. However, a nutritious diet is importan for them because the fast growth increases (增加) the needs for these nutrients. If you teenagers want to be thin, make sure that it's appropriate (价当的) and I suggest you teach them to ask themselves some questions like "Am I really overweight?" If they did diet, help them to do so sensibly. Strict or popular diets will be low in important nutrients and unsuccessful dicting can even lower self-esteem. Sensible eating an regular exercise are the key to beauty success. Cut down on sugary and fatty foods thave fewer calories while still having nutrients. The teenage years are a time whereating disorders can develop. If you think your teenager may have one, speak to you doctor or get in touch with us for information and advice.
