At 6:00 pm, Lily got back home with her head down. She was very worried. Today the class teacher

My classmates sometimes ask me, "Jane, is it safe to be vulnerable (脆弱的) and share my story? Will it make people not believe in me?"

People believe that sharing vulnerability is weak. But it is not true. In fact, sharing vulnerability is a way of facing our life positively (积极地). Being vulnerable and sharing our stories and troubles show we are brave and strong. It is another feeling we need to know about.

Here is an example. There are two teachers. They will teach you how to speak in front of others. The first one talks about his diploma (文凭) from the university. The second shares a story of how he faced fears to find the confidence (自信心) to speak in public for the first time. Which one would you feel closer to? I think it's the second one.

We have found that sharing vulnerability makes us strong and brave, so now the question is "How to share it in the right way?"

The right way is to share our story from the positive side. In the end, we can learn the lessons and get a powerful encouraging message.

A few days ago, I had my first class meeting and deeply shared how I felt from a positive side. In the class, I felt very vulnerable. But finally I decided to go public with it. So I shared my fears. I shared

how my mind was trying to play with me every day and questioned (质疑) if I was good enough. Many classmates had the same feelings. Who doesn't have trouble every day? Then I shared how I faced my fears. My classmates truly agreed with me and my story brought them closer to me.

Our stories help us find our life purpose (目的). So sharing them becomes a positive thing, not something to fear.
