I will never forget the tenth summer of childhood with my grandfather in western Norway at the mountain farm where my mother was born. As a boy, I always thought people simply bought whatever they need. Whether Grandfather knows this, I don't know. One day he said, "Come, I have something for you."

I followed him to a workroom. "You should have a toy boat. You can sail it at Storvassdal." He said. Great, I thought, looking around for the boat. But there was none.

Grandfather pointed to a block of wood. "The boat is there," he said. Then he handed me some tools

and showed me how to use them properly. "It' ll be a fine boat, and you' ll make it with your own hands," he said, "No one can give you what you do for yourself." The words rang in my head as I worked. After I finished the boat, it wasn't much to look at, but I was proud. Then I sailed it at Storvassdal.

We had to return to America. "You cannot bring that boat home with you," my mother said. We already had too much baggage. Feeling sad, I hid my boat under a big rock at Storvassdal.

I said good-bye to Grandfather, not knowing I would never see him again.

In 1964, I went to Storvassdal with my parents and my wife and children. To my surprise, for 34 years my treasure stayed here, waiting. for my return. I felt <u>we three</u> were together again although my grandfather had died 22 years before.

I carved "1930" and "1964" on its side and put it back.

I returned to the lake in 1968, 1971, 1977 and 1988. Each time I had the boat and carved the year, my grandfather seemed near.

My last trip to Storvassdal was in 1991. I brought my granddaughters: Catherine, 13; Claire, 12. I hoped they would understand the importance of the little boat and its simple message. At Storvassdal, Claire said softly, "Grandpa, someday I'll come back." She added, "And I'll bring my children."

Entertainment (娱乐) is a developing business. Its popularity continues to grow as it keeps up with

technology. More people are willing to pa_{*}y for entertainment with their time and money. Sometimes entertainment is an escape(逃避). It takes us away from our reality and gets us into another world — not our own.

• Why do we want to escape?

Boredom or loneliness: The boredom of daily life gets to us and we feel we need some excitement and a bit change. A TV running in the background, and maybe catching our attention every now and then, keeps us company.

Fear and avoidance: We don't want to face something we fear, or can't bring ourselves to move past the fear and do something about it. We're scared to go for what we want, so we choose to turn on the TV.

Struggle: Life sometimes feels like a battle—traffic, work, taking care of ourselves and keeping up with what's going on. At the end of the day all we want to do is forgetting about all of it and sitting mindlessly in front of TV.

Escaping has never been easier than today. We have many forms of escape. And the most favored is entertainment.

Self entertainment: You can stay at home and watch TV, or surf online all day long.

Social connection: One can line up for a new movie and connect with other people or go to a ballgame and cheer for his or her favorite team. Entertainment has become something people have in common and can talk about.

All forms of entertainment are okay if we know what we're doing. And more importantly, we have complete control over when entertainment comes to an end.

To face our fears and reality or to escape?

If you tried escaping before and it didn't help, it's time to deal with the problems you face.

Before watching a TV show, make sure that the important thing is taken care of. Leave your favorite show to the end of the day, after you' ve taken care of what matters to you. This will allow you to enjoy every minute.

There is nothing wrong with entertainment, if we don't place a higher value on it than our own reality and what matters to us.

When we entertain ourselves mindfully, we won't need to escape. We turn entertainment into the reality of the moment. And when we're done, we move on — with no regret. And that can be a lot of fun.
