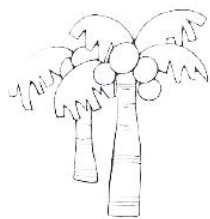

第一档：（10—9分）

内容：完全符合题目要求，达到写作目的；信息点齐全；语法结构和词汇丰富。

表达：字体工整，语言通顺，语意连贯；语言知识错误不超过 2个；大小写和标点错误不超过3个，满分不允许有任何错误。

第二档：（6--8分）

内容：符合题目要求，基本达到写作目的；信息点基本齐全；语法结构和词汇基本满足文章需要。

表达：书写清楚，语言基本通顺，语意基本连贯；语言知识错误 3个以上，大小写和标点错误4个以上，但所有错误不影响整体理解。

第三档：（4--5分）

内容：部分符合题目要求，没完全达到写作目的；漏掉主要信息，无关内容较多；语法结构单调，词汇有限。

表达：书写潦草，语言不通顺，语意难以理解；语言知识错误、大小写和标点错误较多，影响整体理解。

第四档：（3--1分）

内容：不符合题目要求，没达到写作目的；有效内容很少；语法结构混乱，词汇贫乏。

表达：言不达意，语言知识错误、大小写和标点错误随处可见。
