To get to the tennis court (球场), Conner Stroud has to push his wheelchair there.

The 15-year-old boy from North Carolina, US was born without 13. But when he picks up his racquet (球拍) and begins to hit a ball, you quickly see that the young man just wants to 14.

Stroud began playing tennis at age 5 at the small tennis club which his parents owned. For years, he played against able-bodied players by putting rubber (橡胶) on the stumps (残余部分) of his legs. Though he was a foot (英尺) or two shorter than many of the players he played against, he won a number of matches. He became well-known enough that he got to 15 Rafael Nadal, his favorite player, at the US Open in 2013.

"The most important thing is that he's 16," Nadal told reporters about Stroud after that 15-minute meeting. "He's playing tennis... That's a great example of being happy even if your 17 doesn't give you everything."

Stroud started playing wheelchair tennis at 13 and now he is No. 1 in the US.

Earlier this summer, he played for the US in the world's biggest junior wheelchair team 18 event—the World Team Cup. He played six matches and won five of them as the US won the cup for the first time since 2000.

"He is a polite boy, but he will rip (撕扯) your heart out trying to beat you," Jason Harnett, a United States Tennis Association coach, said of Stroud. "You see that attitude in a lot of the best players, whether they are able-bodied or disabled (残疾的)."



Teenage players can often get disappointed and angry. They may 19 their racquet or shout at themselves after they miss shots. However, Stroud 20 does that.

“I just try to stay positive,” Stroud said. “After every point, I try to say I’m going to win the next point, or the next game, or the next match if I lose the whole match. There’s always a chance to be positive. You can always win another time.”

Best Friends

Men and women share the exact same view of a best friend—a person who is always there for you. A best friend is someone you can depend on to share your happiness, suffer through your worries, or lessen your sorrow (悲伤). As one man put it, "To me, a best friend is somebody who you call if you're on the road and get a flat tire (爆胎) at 3:00 a. m. and you've been told it's four hours until a tow truck (拖车) can be sent. Your friend says, 'Tell me exactly where you are, and I'll come and get you.'"

Different things lead to the birth of a best friendship—the age and situations in which people meet, what first attracts them, why they remain close, and how they fill each other's needs. Yet I find the most important points that explain the meaning of a best friend are remarkably (显著地) similar across most experiences. Safety is a word I heard over and over. A best friend makes

you feel safe, protected and comfortable. You never have to explain yourself to best friends because they really, really know who you are. With best friends, you can be who you are. You can cry too hard or laugh too loud and never worry what they'll think of you because best friends are nonjudgmental (客观的). They will give you advice if you want ideas and **give you a kick in the pants** if you need encouragement, but best friends will not judge you or make you feel ashamed of your behaviors. A best friend gives you what you expect from a parent and doesn't always get: unconditional love.

Best friends are loyal (忠诚的) and trustworthy. A best friend is a person to whom you can tell your most shameful, truthful and harmful personal secrets with the full confidence they will never be repeated. Best friends can deliver brutally (冷酷无情地) honest answers in the most gentle way.

Finally, best friends are the family you choose. They love you because they want to, not because they have to. And for many people, a best friend becomes the brother or sister they'd always wanted, but never had.

A man I knew asked his dying mother, "What has been the most important thing in your life?" He fully expected her to say her husband, her children or her family. Instead, without a moment's hesitation (犹豫), she replied sweetly, "My friends."

Everyone talks about the advantage of taking time out for “simple pleasures”. The idea is that we will be happier if we often do inexpensive, easy-to-do activities.

However, the problem for many of us is that we don't know what makes us happy.

When I was in college, my mother gave me some wise advice. She said, “Before you get married and live with another person, you need to spend some time living by yourself. You need to get to know yourself.”

So I did exactly that. For almost two years, I lived by myself. I found that I loved to spend hours looking around in bookstores. I also loved to spend an afternoon just walking around the city. And every so often, I needed the moments of pure silence.

But, of course, we all don't enjoy the same things.

A simple pleasure for me would be to spend an hour reading a book in my backyard. However, that same activity would give my husband no pleasure. We are all so different.

Sometimes, we already know what makes us happy. However, as life gets busier and we get older, we put aside our simple pleasures.

For example, I had to give up playing the flute (长笛) when I started working and had family responsibilities. Playing my flute seemed selfish (自私的) when no one else in my family could join, but three years ago I returned to playing the flute. I regret having ever stopped.

Simple pleasures are neither simple nor universal (普遍的).

Our simple pleasures are a reflection (反映) of who we are. They are different activities that give each of us joy.

Certainly there are some common topics—such as being out in nature, doing something creative, or enjoying music and literature—but beyond that, each of us has to find out what it is that feeds our souls (灵魂).

That isn't always easy in a world in which we have to consider other people's needs and opinions as well as our own, but enjoying simple pleasures is something that each of us deserves (应得).

Think of it as your right, and say to yourself, “Today, I'm going to discover what my simple pleasures are.”

While Wang and Huang did their homework at home, Ding Zhenzhen, 15, of No. 5 Middle School, had to go outside. She worked as a guide in the local museum. "Everyone at our school has to take part in volunteering or other activities," she said.

Ding was a guide in the gallery (展馆) of coins. She got brochures (小册子) from the museum, but she still did research and added more information to her introduction. She worked three hours a day and had no time to take a break. But she felt it was a meaningful experience. "My communication skills are improved," she said.
