

Children didn't have many ways to enjoy themselves in ancient times. However, they came up with interesting games to play in their free time.

Kicking stone balls	More than 300 years ago, kicking stone balls around was popular in the north of China. It was easy to play. Children often played the game in winter in order to keep warm.
Playing hide-and-seek	Hide-and-seek is a traditional game for children. There are two ways to play: covering a child's eyes while other children run around to tease (戏弄) him or others hide and one child must try to find them.
	Kites have quite a long history. The three most famous kites are the Beijing kite, Tianjin kite and Weifang kite. For example, the bird-shaped (形状) kite with long wings(翅膀) is a special kind of the Beijing kite.



This was not a real letter. But Copeland says she received this kind of letter when she was young. While many dancers start at the age of three, Copeland only began to study ballet in 1995 as a thirteen-year-old girl. People often told her that she was too old, or that she didn't have the perfect body shape (She is only 157cm tall). Her family moved a lot, and it was sometimes difficult for her to have ballet classes. But Copeland loved dancing and did not want to give up. She stayed with her ballet teacher during the week and spent time with her family only at the weekend. This was a difficult life, but she worked hard and won her first national match when she was fourteen years old. Copeland joined the American Ballet Theatre in 2000 and performed(表演) in many ballets over the next few years. In 2007, she became a solo dancer(独舞者), and in 2015 she became the most important dancer.



Copeland is now a dancer, writer and Broadway performer. She also stars in the film A Ballerina's Tale. So what's next? Copeland thinks anything is possible: "My work life is really just now beginning."

Do you know anything about lightning? What makes it? When do lightning strikes happen?

Lightning strikes happen when ice and water in clouds rub (摩擦) together, and cause atmospheric (大气层的) changes. When this happens, it produces a static charge (静电). Lightning can strike inside the clouds. It can also strike between a cloud and Earth- this kind is more dangerous for people.

Lighting can be very dangerous. Every year, lighting hurts people because it can start big fires or because it can get to 28,000 degrees. Every year lightning hits about 1,000 people in the United States, and about 100 of them die from it.

Lightning makes people afraid, and it happens all over the world! Scientists think that there are more than three million lighting strikes every day in the world--that's thirty strikes every second. An American man, Roy Sullivan, was born in 1912. He began working in a park in 1936. He survived from the most lightning strikes. Between 1942 and 1977, lightning hit him seven times! He didn't die from them although he experienced the most lightning strikes in the world. Many people see him as the luckiest man in the word!

Lightning is sure not something to play with. I can put you in danger. So, when lightning strikes, it's best to stay inside a large building. To stay safe, do not stand under trees or power lines, on hills or near water. Also, do not lie down on the ground, or the electricity (电) may go through you and cause a heart problem.

Health researchers say in the US, adults (成年人) now sit about 6.5 hours a day. That is up about an hour a day compared to 2007. The news is even worse for middle school students. The National Center for Health Statistics collected the numbers for the past 16 years and found that students sit 8 hours each day. The researchers are worried about this finding.

Too much sitting has bad effect (影响) on people. Study shows that people who do not often do outdoor sports can get ill more easily. People burn (燃烧) fewer calories (卡路里) so that they put on too much fat. They might even get serious illness such as heart problems. They are also at risk for high blood pressure (血压).

What do people do in the free time? About 60% of people in the US watch at least two hours of TV each day. That number doesn't change much these years.

Computers are the biggest reason for more hours spent sitting. Computer use outside of work or school is going up for all age groups. Now, 50% of adults spend at least an hour of their free time on a computer each day. That is up from 29% in 2020. About 53% of middle school students now spend at least an hour of free time on computers. So do 56% of little children.

Standing up and doing sports help in lots of ways. It can burn more calories, make you happier and give you more energy (能量). It can also help you sleep better. So get up, take some breaks and go outside. You might save your life by doing outdoor activities. There are many choices for you.
