She went deeper and deeper. Then she saw something shiny. She took it out. It was a gold coin. She made it clean. There were words on it: Make a wish before the rainbow fades.

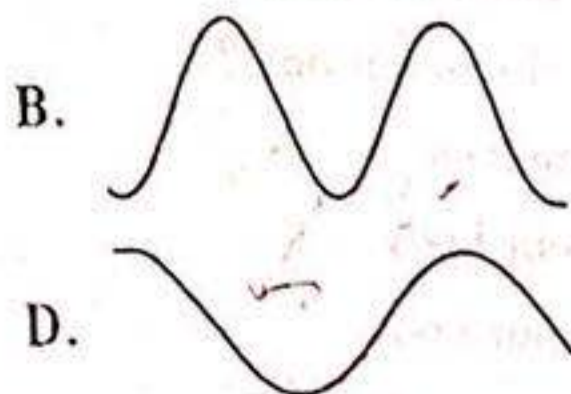
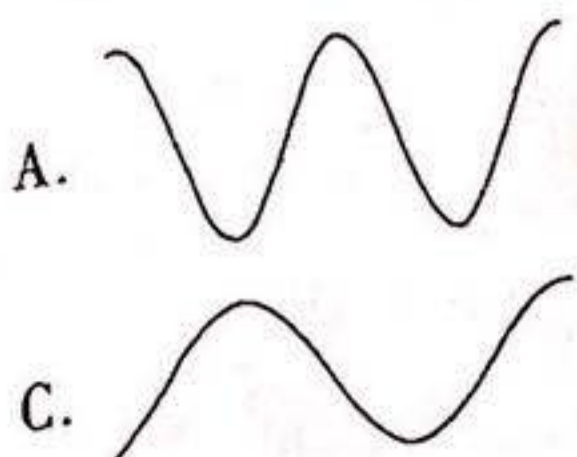
"This is amazing! A wish!" Milly said. Her head began to fill with ideas. But then she saw the rainbow fading.

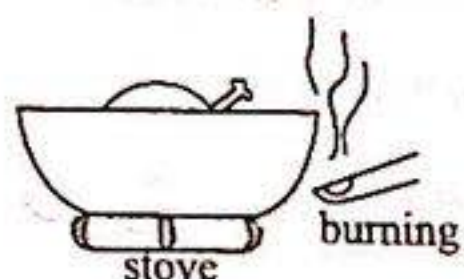
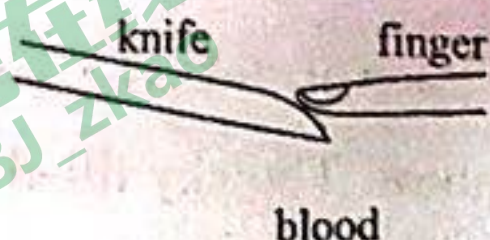

Human bodies are a miracle (奇迹). Let's look at one example first.

How can you tell whether something is hot or cold? You touch it. There are things in your fingers that help you to know whether something is hot or cold. They're called nerves (神经). You have them all over your body. Nerves react (反应) to things we touch and send messages (消息) through our bodies to our brains, telling us how something feels.

If you touched the edge of a knife, how would that feel? It would hurt. If you didn't have nerves, you would still bleed, but it wouldn't hurt. You wouldn't be able to feel it. So, why are nerves a good thing? We would hurt ourselves a lot more without them.



Imagine that you're making a snack in the kitchen. You put your hand down on the stove. After a minute or two, you see some smoke rising in the air. It's your hand! It's burning! If you had no nerves, you wouldn't be able to feel the heat from the stove. Then you would have to go to the hospital.

If we had no nerves, the weather wouldn't affect (影响) us, or would it? If it were below 0°C , you wouldn't feel how cold it was. But if you went outside without protecting (保护) your body from the cold, you could get very sick or die. Nerves help us stay safe and healthy.

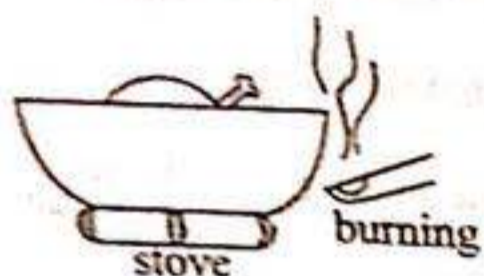
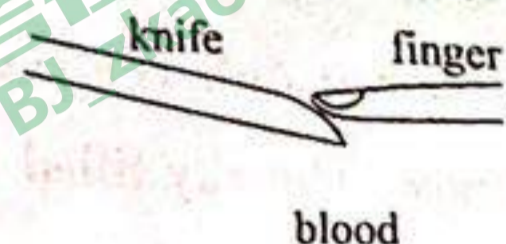
