### Going to the Library

The library is a great place to visit for help with schoolwork. It opens up new worlds, makes you imagine, encourages reading and helps you in school and in life. But the library isn't just about reading and learning. You can have fun in the library, too. Some libraries hold fun events for children, such as story telling, making things and book hunting. And when you go to your library, there is always someone there to help you find what you want. That someone is a librarian.

You can ask your librarian to help you find books about any subject that interests you.

Libraries have books about everything from planes to zebras. If you like to read fiction (虚构小说), your librarian can suggest (建议) adventure books, fantasy books and many more. If you are having a hard time finding an answer to a question, ask your librarian to help you find the answer. Your librarian can help you locate (定位) information in magazines and newspapers, and on the computer.

Libraries are also great places to go if you want a quiet and relaxing place to read or study. They have areas with cozy chairs where you can curl up (蜷缩) and read a book. They also have tables and chairs where you can work on school reports. And most libraries have lots of bright reading areas, so you won't hurt your eyes by closely looking at that tiny print.

A British girl, Taryn Everdeen, has just finished writing a novel(小说) with her favorite writer, Carolyn Meyer, even though she is 66 years younger than her.

Taryn was only 15 years old, when she first wrote a fan letter to 81year-old Carolyn Meyer, to give thanks for her historical novels.

"Carolyn was one of my favorite writers. I grew up reading her books. When I was nine or ten, I would listen to her stories every night ...That made me fall in love with history," says Taryn.



Taryn, who is from Norwich, England, was then surprised when Carolyn wrote back and suggested writing a novel together.

Carolyn is an American writer who writes novels for children and young people. She has published (出版) over 60 children books, but she has never wanted to work with another writer until she got Taryn's letter.

Three years ago, after Taryn wrote to her, Carolyn invited the young girl to stay with her in the US, so they could write a novel together. They decided (决定) to write a time-traveling story. They sent ideas to each other by email. Carolyn also visited Taryn last year, and Taryn flew to the US over the summer, after she finished her school exams.

They now have a first draft (初稿) of "*Mirror of Time*". They decide to give it to some publishers and hope they will be interested in it.

"This is my first try at writing a novel. We have been working on it for three years. It's amazing," says Taryn. And I have never met anyone like her. "She seems much younger than her age. I think she is a really powerful role model(有影响 力的榜样). She's my teacher, and my work partner, but I see her as a friend more than anything else."

Taryn, now 18 years old, returns from the USA this week. She wants to have a gap year(间隔年) before starting university next year.

"We worked hard, but we did other things together, too. While I was there, we went to a few theatre shows, and we went on a journey to Taos, staying in a hotel overnight there."

"She's very open, and I can talk to her about pretty much all the things I talk to my other friends about," she says. "She has taught me how to be a better writer."
