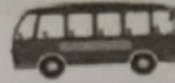

More Animals are Becoming Night Owls (猫头鹰)

Some animals move around most at night. They sleep in the day. Then they are active after dark. There is a name for these animals. They are called nocturnal.

Not all animals are nocturnal, of course. Some move around most during the day. But a new study says many of these daytime animals are changing. Now, they are hiding out during the day. They are moving around more at night.

What is causing (导致) the change? People are, the study says.

Scientists know that people affect (影响) how animals act. Animals keep a close watch when people are near. They spend less time looking for food. Sometimes people move to places where animals live. Then the animals may move away. Other animals may stay, but move around less. They do not want to run into people.

A group of scientists did a study. They learned something new. All human (人类) activity affects how animals behave. Even activities like hiking and camping can make animals afraid. These activities do not seem so bad. But they are causing animals to be less active during the day. These animals are choosing to move around at night, instead.

Is this good or bad for animals? It may be both. Kaitlyn Gaynor, a scientist, said this change will be difficult for some animals. They are not used to moving around at night. Their lives may be harder now. For other animals, the change might help, though. It may cut down their chance of running into people. This is safer for animals. It is safer for people, too.

So maybe this is a safer way to share the planet. "Humans can do their thing during the day," Ms. Gaynor said. "Wildlife can do their thing at night."
